Home of Košice's professional orchestra in the former synagogue.



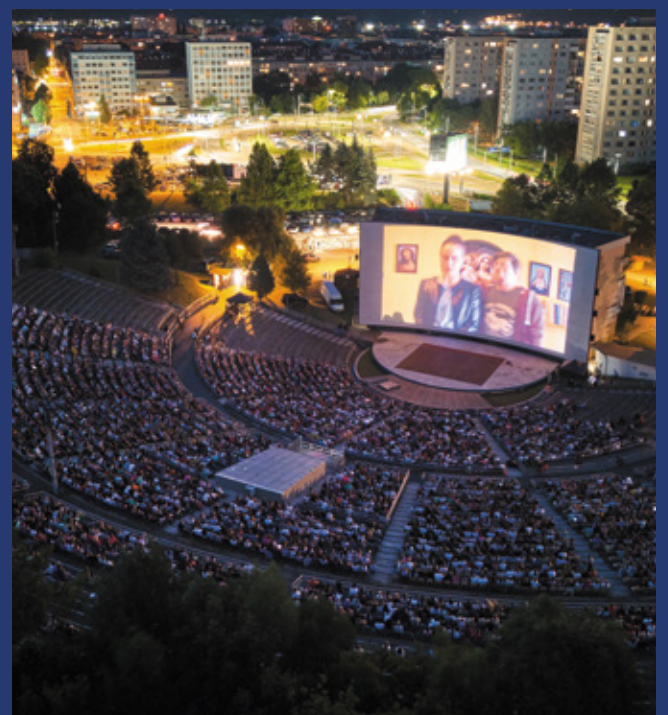
Kunsthalle/Hall of Art

Come and watch special original plays written by the actors from the independent theater in the city center. Enjoy a glass of wine from Slovak vineyards and discuss all the details of their performance in the adjacent café.

Stop by the Historical building of the museum and explore the exhibition of the Košice Golden Treasure. The Division building features science-related exhibits on the Carpathian nature, as well as an art history section titled *Centuries of Art*.

Slovak Technical Museum
